Introduction

The year 2025 marked a significant milestone in the growth and development of Esports in Ghana. Esports Association Ghana (EAG) continued to strengthen its mandate of promoting Esports development, talent discovery, community engagement, and international representation through strategic partnerships, tournaments, championships, and national activations.



This report highlights all key activities, collaborations, and milestones undertaken by the Association from January to December 2025.





Summary Of Activities By Month

January 2025

Accra Esports Week

In collaboration with Popout Ghana, Esports Association Ghana contributed to the hosting of the Accra Esports Week, a week-long Esports celebration from January 7th to January 14th. The event featured competitive gaming, exhibitions, community engagements, and industry networking, setting the tone for the Esports calendar year.

Ghana Pro Clubs League

Following Accra Esports Week, the Association collaborated on the official launch of the Ghana Pro Clubs League, providing structured competitive opportunities for 11v11 esports teams across the country. The Ghana Pro Clubs League is the most consistent esports engagement in Ghana over the years. Tremendous efforts have been put in by the community managers and leaders of the Ghana Pro Clubs League, who continue to push boundaries with each season of the tournament.

February 2025

Ashanti Regional Championship

The Esports Association Ghana organized the Ashanti Regional Championship, expanding competitive esports beyond Accra and strengthening regional participation. Other scheduled regional events could not take place as planned due to lack of funds.

VGA Esports GRID

Esports Association Ghana supported and participated in the VGA Esports GRID, contributing to grassroots and semi-professional esports development.

Maiden Esports Rugby League

Esports Association Ghana successfully launched the first-ever Esports Rugby League, introducing a new competitive esports format to the Ghanaian ecosystem.

Play for Love Esports Tournament

In partnership with Metro TV, the Association hosted the Play for Love Esports Tournament on Valentine's Day, combining esports with social engagement and media coverage.

Sankofa Esports Championship

Esports Association Ghana collabo-



rated with the Black Our Story Festival to host the Sankofa Esports Championship, promoting African heritage through esports competition.

Partnership with Future of Work 2.0

Esports Association Ghana entered into a strategic partnership with Future of Work 2.0, reinforcing esports as a viable career and digital skills pathway for Ghanaian youth.

March 2025

Blur Championship (Independence Day)

To commemorate Ghana's Independence Day, the Association hosted the Blur Championship, celebrating national pride through esports competition.

NBA2K International Schools Tournament

In collaboration with the Association of International Certification Schools Ghana, EAG organized an NBA2K Tournament for international schools, promoting esports in educational institutions.





IESF World Championship – Ghana Qualifiers

The Association successfully hosted the National Qualifiers for the IESF World Championship, selecting Ghana’s representatives for international competition. Qualifications were done in PUBG Mobile and Mobile Legends Bang Bang for participation in the Regional Qualifiers towards World Esports Championship 2025.

Global Esports Federation Membership Renewal

In March, Esports Association Ghana membership with the Global Esports Federation was renewed, reaffirming its commitment to global esports standards and governance.

April 2025

FC25 & Blur Tournament at STEM & Esports Meetup

EAG hosted FC25 and Blur tournaments during the Ghana Science, Technology, Engineering, Mathematics, Innovation, and Esports Meetup, an initia-



tive by IOT, promoting esports within innovation and technology spaces.

Maiden Efootball League Ghana

In partnership with the Saudi Efootball Community, the Association hosted the maiden edition of the Efootball League Ghana, strengthening international esports collaboration.

May 2025

Decathlon Ghana 8th Anniversary Esports Tournament

Esports Association Ghana partnered with Decathlon Ghana to host an esports tournament as part of their 8th Anniversary celebrations, blending sports retail and esports engagement.

Number Nineteen Esports Championship

In collaboration with Alexis Laura, the Association hosted an esports activation at Number Nineteen, Airport Residential Area, targeting lifestyle and premium community audiences.

June 2025

SallahFest Esports Games

EAG hosted the SallahFest Esports Games, engaging communities through culturally inclusive esports celebrations.

Apex League Championship

The Association supported the Apex League Championship at the 4Syte TV Mansion, combining entertainment, media, and competitive esports.

July 2025

GHANA ESPORTS LEAGUE

The Ghana Esports League (GEL) Pre-Season Edition was organized by EAG as a pilot competitive phase to test league operations, player readiness, tournament formats, broadcast workflows, and community engagement ahead of the full league season. The pre-season brought together 16 esports teams, each comprising four (4) professional gamers, who competed over a four-week pre-season period. This phase served as a foundational step in building a sustainable national esports league structure for Ghana.
